SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Introduction

Watermaster filed a notice of motion, motion and memorandum of points and authorities concerning the status of negotiations with the Department of Water Resources (DWR) and the OBMP on August 31, 1999. This is submitted as a supplement to that filing.

Background

Watermaster conducted a public hearing on September 15, 1999, at 9:00 a.m. in the City of Ontario Council Chambers. (Stewart Supp. Decl., paragraph 3.) At that hearing, oral comments were heard by the Watermaster Board regarding the OBMP Phase I Report. (Ibid.) The Board members discussed the comments and took action to forward the Phase I Report to the Court. (Stewart Supp. Decl., paragraph 5.) A transcript of the hearing is included in the "Optimum Basin Management Program Appendix A – Public Comments." (See Stewart Supp. Decl., Exhibit "C.")

Receive and File the OBMP Phase I Report

There is consensus among the parties the OBMP Phase I Report, including all written and oral comments, should be submitted to the Court to be received and filed as a Phase I Report.

Conclusion

The Court is requested to:

- (1) Order the OBMP to be developed in two phases;
- (2) Receive and file the OBMP Phase I Report;
- (3) Cancel the October 28, 1999, hearing on the Watermaster Board;
- (4) Schedule a hearing for April 30, 2000, on the continuation of the nine-member

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
DECLARATION OF TRACI STEWART
