The Court congratulates the parties on the preparation of, and timely release for comment, the Draft Implementation Plan for the Optimum Basin Management Program ("OBMP") for the Chino Basin. The Court recognizes the efforts of all those involved in having achieved the substantial progress made to date on the OBMP. Such progress would be impossible but for the diligence of all who are involved.

The Court also commends the Watermaster in its efforts to inform the public about the OBMP and to maintain open lines of communication with such related public agencies such as the Flood Control District, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, the Association of Groundwater Agencies, and the Santa Ana Rivershed Group. Most importantly, the Court appreciates the Watermaster's efforts to build consensus for the adoption and implementation of the OBMP. The Court takes an interest in the Watermaster's meeting and workshop schedule and requests that it be posted on its website as soon as possible.

The Court is pleased to see that Watermaster is aggressively approaching funding issues related to the adoption and implementation of the OBMP. The funding issues are crucial to the success of the plan. The Court shares the Watermaster's hope that the delay in preparation of the draft Environmental Impact Report will not affect the timely completion of the final version.

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From the paperwork submitted, the Court sees that there may be some outstanding legal issues, which, if left unresolved, might inhibit further progress in the adoption of a Final OBMP. In view of the commitment of the parties and the Court to adherence to the time schedule adopted in the Final Ruling on the September 30, 1999, hearing, the Court believes it is desirable to set a further status conference on the OBMP. The Court hereby schedules a further status hearing at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 6, 2000, to determine whether there are any outstanding legal issues that need to be addressed, and if so, to define such issues. Interested parties are requested to submit briefs by no later than Thursday, March 30, 2000. Should the Court determine on April 6 that a determination of legal issues is necessary to ensure the timely adoption of the Final OBMP, interested parties will be invited to submit initial briefs no later than Tuesday, April 18, 2000, responding briefs no later than Tuesday, April 25, 2000, and fax-filing of reply briefs (909-948-4569—this brief only number) no later than April 27, 2000. A hearing for a determination on the legal issues will be set for Thursday, May 4, 2000.
