	20	I, SCOTT S. SLATER, declare:					
	21	1. I am an attorney licensed to practice law before the courts of the State of California.					
	22	am general counsel for the Chino Basin Watermaster (Watermaster). I have served as general					
	23	counsel since March 2000, and in that time have been personally involved in all aspects of					
	24	Watermaster reporting. I have personal knowledge of the following and, if called as a witness,					
	25	could and would testify competently to the following.					
	26	2. At a hearing before the honorable Judge Wade on November 13, 2008, the Court					
	27	directed Watermaster to suspend the filing of further reports pending the scheduled hearing before					
	28	the Court on February 2, 2009.					
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- 3. At the conclusion of the hearing on February 2, 2009, the Court instructed general counsel to prepare a summary of the Watermaster reports and their status and to serve the summary on the Parties to the Judgment.
- 4. Further, in response to inquiry from Watermaster Counsel Mr. Fife, the Court indicated that Watermaster should continue preparation of the OBMP Status Reports as well as other reports previously ordered by Judge Gunn pending further Court review at the hearing now scheduled for April 27, 2009.
- 5. The Court directed that the declaration should provide a statement of the status of all reports for the Watermaster, then due or soon to be produced.
- 6. Pursuant to the Court's direction, Watermaster has prepared a summary spreadsheet that is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "A." The spreadsheet describes the regular Watermaster and related reports that routinely occurs regarding surface and groundwater relevant to the management of the Chino Basin.
- 7. The comprehensive reporting is done by Watermaster independently and in coordination with public agencies tasked with the responsibility under existing law.
- Watermaster customarily and routinely publishes the reports in a draft and final form to the member Parties to the Chino Basin Judgment and vets them through the open public review process before each of the Pools, the Advisory Committee and the Board.
- 9. All reports produced by Watermaster submitted to each of the three Pools, the Advisory Committee, and the Board for subject to review, comment, revision and approval to ensure accuracy.
- 10. Before any report is finalized and released for publication and filing, it has been circulated to the Parties to the Judgment for at least a month.
- The public may obtain copies of any report prepared by Watermaster or at its 11. direction through the website or by the attendance at open meetings where the reports are discussed. None of the identified reports are considered confidential.

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- 12. All identified reports under preparation of Watermaster are complete unless otherwise noted in this declaration. Watermaster will also offer Mr. Manning as the staff person most knowledgeable regarding the reporting at the April 27, 2002 hearing.
- 13. The OBMP Status Reports (2008-02) were in production at the time of the November 13, 2008 hearing. Preparation of the report was temporarily suspended. Following the February 2, 2009 hearing, Watermaster resumed preparation of the report. Thus, Status Report 2008-02 is untimely. However, it has now been completed and submitted to the Court.
- 14. The 2008 Annual Report was submitted to the Court on March 3, 2009. Under the Judgment, this report is required to be submitted to the Court in January. Watermaster routinely experiences difficulty in meeting the time requirement for filing this report. This is largely due to a change in circumstance since the report was envisioned in 1978 when the Judgment was entered. The early form of the report was simple and consisted of a few type-written pages which were copied and stapled together. Today the report covers vastly greater subject matter and content and is a bound volume that is professionally printed. Because of production requirements with the printers, it is not possible to submit the Annual Report according to the timetable described in the Judgment.
  - 15. All other Watermaster's reports are timely produced and submitted.
- 16. The status of reporting covered in the attachment reflects those reports that are routine, customary or that otherwise arise from an order of the Court. It is not intended to address all or anticipate filings or reports that may be triggered in the future by objective standards in the Judgment and its progeny (Peace Agreement, Peace II Measures) or by conduct of the Parties to the Judgment or third parties in the future.
- 17. For clarification and the avoidance of doubt, Judge Gunn's Order of December 21, 2007 requires Watermaster to comply with the terms of the Peace II Agreement, including Article V, Section 5.3(b) and to receive quarterly reports from Western Municipal Water District (WMWD) regarding its progress in implementing the Future Desalters program. This is a report generated by WMWD and then included with the materials submitted to the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board). To avoid redundant reporting, Watermaster will transmit

the reports submitted to the Regional Board to the Court. Mr. Manning will be available to address this issue in greater detail on April 27, 2009 if so desired by the Court.

18. Watermaster intends to address any issue regarding the form and substance of governance and administration of the Judgment by Watermaster in response to a specific issue that may be raised by any Party to the Judgment at the time it is raised or as the Court may direct or if there is no direction, then in connection with any motion to re-appoint the Nine-Member Board as presently scheduled by Order of Judge Gunn for 2010.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.
