

RESOLUTION 79-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CHINO BASIN WATERMASTER
EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF IN LIEU
AREA NO. 2 ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 78-3

WHEREAS, Chino Basin Watermaster needs to promote the use of available surface water supplies in lieu of pumping from the Chino Groundwater Basin to circumvent as much production in excess of operating safe yield in light of limited water spreading capacity and the requirement to maintain water levels; and

WHEREAS, Judgment in Chino Basin Case No. 164327 entitled "Chino Basin Municipal Water District v. City of Chino, et al" established In Lieu Area No. 1 for a specific limited purpose inadequate for the current need; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California has initiated temporary in lieu programs from time to time under which several producers qualify to the benefit of the Chino Groundwater Basin; and


WHEREAS, Watermaster adopted Resolution 78-3 which established In Lieu Area No. 2 to incorporate all qualified producers for the period February 15, 1978 through June 30, 1979; and


WHEREAS, participating in The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California In Lieu Programs will continue to demonstrate the need of such in lieu programs in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Chino Basin Watermaster hereby extends the effective date of Resolution 78-3 to maintain In Lieu Area No. 2 until at least June 30, 1980 for producers in the Basin who qualify under the in lieu provision of the Judgment (EXHIBIT "H", Section 11, Page 75) and in lieu programs offered by the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California for water delivered by the Pomona Valley Municipal Water District or the Chino Basin Municipal Water District.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was adopted this 29th day of May, 1979.
