

RESOLUTION 99-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CHINO BASIN WATERMASTER LEVYING REPLENISHMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999- 2000

WHEREAS, the Chino Basin Watermaster was appointed on January 27, 1978, under Case No. RCV 51010 (formerly case No. SCV 164327) entitled Chino Basin Municipal Water District v. City of Chino, et al., with powers to levy and collect administrative and replenishment assessments necessary to maintain water levels and to cover the cost of administering the Chino Basin Judgment; and

WHEREAS, the Chino Basin Watermaster adopted an amended administrative budget for Fiscal Year 1999-2000 on June 10, 1999, which was approved by the Watermaster Advisory Committee on June 10, 1999, in the amount of \$2,530,017 to carry out the necessary functions contained in the Judgment; and

WHEREAS, the parties named in this Judgment have pumped 657.472 acre-feet of water in excess of the operating safe yield, which is required to be replaced at the expense of the parties in accordance with the assessment formulas for the respective pools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chino Basin Watermaster levies the respective assessments for each pool effective November 18, 1999 as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Judgment, each party has thirty (30) days from the date of invoice to remit payment for assessments due from date of notice. After this date, interest will accrue as provided for in Section 55 (c) of the Judgment.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was approved by the Advisory Committee on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 1999 and adopted by the Watermaster Board on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November 1999.


