

DYY Agreement Documents

The Dry Year Yield (“DYY”) Program is a large scale storage and recovery program in the Chino Basin with the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (“MWD”). Under DYY Program, and the agreements that implement it, MWD has the right to store up to 100,000 acre-feet of water in the Chino Basin. Extensive technical analysis was conducted prior to implementation of this program and this information is therefore helpful in order to understand the capabilities and constraints associated with the storage of water in the Chino Basin through the Storage and Recovery Program.
