Since 2001, Watermaster prepares a State of the Basin report every two years that describes the groundwater conditions in the basin. These reports describe groundwater availability (production, depth to water and storage), artificial recharge, subsidence, water quality and the status of various monitoring and management programs. The findings in the State of the Basin report are based on extensive monitoring and detailed numerical modeling. The latest report available is the draft 2009 report that describes the state of the Chino Basin in 2008.
