STOEL RIVES LLP ATTORNEYS AT LAW

I, Elizabeth P. Ewens, declare as follows:

- 1. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein, and if called and sworn as a witness, could and would testify competently hereto. I am a partner with the law firm Stoel Rives LLP and am counsel of record for the City of Ontario ("Ontario") in this action.
- 2. I make this declaration in support of Ontario's Motion for Award of Attorney's Fees and Costs, following its challenges to the Watermaster's approval of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 Assessment Packages and the related appeals.
- 3. Ontario challenged the Watermaster's adoption of the FY 2021/2022 Assessment Package, which the Superior Court rejected. Ontario timely appealed the Superior Court's November 3, 2022 Order denying the challenge (case no. E080457).
- 4. Ontario subsequently challenged the Watermaster's adoption of the FY 2022/2023 Assessment Package. The Superior Court similarly rejected the challenge and Ontario timely appealed the August 23, 2024 Order denying the challenge (case no. E082127).
- 5. Following a motion by Ontario, the Court of Appeal consolidated appellate cases nos. E080457 and E082127. The record on appeal consisted of a combined 19 volumes of the parties' appendices, totaling 6,461 pages.
- 6. Following briefing of the consolidated appeal, the matter was argued before Division 2 of the Fourth Appellate District on April 1, 2025. The Appellate Court's Opinion was issued on April 18, 2025, reversing the Court's November 3, 2022 and August 23, 2023 Orders. The Appellate Opinion provided that Ontario shall recover its costs on appeal.
- 7. Ontario retained the services of Stoel Rives LLP in March 2022 after its thencounsel identified a conflict of interest with Fontana Water Company with respect to the
  Assessment Package dispute. Fontana declined to grant a waiver for the conflict. The initial
  February 17, 2022 application for an extension was filed by attorney Charisse Smith on behalf of
  Ontario. Ms. Smith was contracted with Ontario for the limited purpose of assisting with the
  application and does not specialize in water law. Ontario was in negotiations with another firm to
  assist with the Assessment Package challenge, however conflicts arose when the attorneys changed
  firms.

8. I served as billing attorney for my law firm on this lawsuit. As billing attorney, I supervised and reviewed all legal services that were performed and billed to Ontario. I also reviewed all invoices before they were submitted to Ontario for payment. The attorneys involved in providing legal services in this matter, in addition to myself, were Michael Brown. Christopher Pooser, Whitney Brown, Janelle Krattiger, Lauren Neuhaus, Max Fujii, and Wade Foster. The paralegal providing services on this matter was Ha Nguyen.

- 9. I reviewed these invoices to ensure that all work included was incurred with respect to Ontario's challenges to the Watermaster approvals of the FY 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 Assessment Packages and the related appeals, that any excessive, redundant or unnecessary time was removed.
- 10. With other attorneys at Stoel Rives, I expended significant time and attention to assist Ontario in this proceeding. Stoel Rives filed a Substitution of Attorney notice with the Court on March 23, 2022. Shortly thereafter, Stoel filed an ex parte application for an order allowing Ontario to exceed the page limits for a combined reply brief in support of its challenge of the FY 2021/2022 Assessment Package approval. Following the ex parte application and hearing, Stoel Rives prepared the extensive combined reply brief to the oppositions to Ontario's challenge of the approval of the FY 2021/2022 Assessment Package. Stoel Rives also assisted with the challenge of Watermaster's approval of the FY 2022/2023 Assessment Packages. Following the Assessment Package challenges, Stoel Rives served as counsel during the appeal of the orders denying the challenges.
- 11. Ontario's challenges were efficiently litigated, utilizing fewer senior attorneys where appropriate. As a public agency, Stoel Rives billed Ontario discounted rates well below the standard billable rates charged by the firm.
- 12. A summary of the approximate hours spent by each attorney and paralegal, through June 30, 2025, related to this proceeding are as follows:

13. Ontario hired Stoel Rives based on Stoel Rives' vast experience in water law and groundwater litigation. My experience and credentials are reflected in my billable hourly rate. I graduated from University of California, Davis School of Law in 1994 and was admitted to practice in Colorado in 1994 and in California in 2001. I have more than 20 years of experience helping clients navigate complex water rights issues, including in the areas of water, environmental, and natural resources law, and representing clients in long-standing water rights disputes and advising them on matters involving water management and regulation of both surface and groundwater rights. This includes the representation of public agencies, State Water Project contractors, and private individuals and entities in complex water resources litigation and adjudications throughout the western United States, including in both state and federal administrative, trial court, and appellate proceedings, as well as in mediation proceedings to achieve negotiated solutions to complex water issues. I am admitted to practice in California, Colorado, and Nevada, and before the United States Supreme Court, United States Court of Federal Claims, the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth and Tenth Circuits, and numerous United States District Courts.

14. Michael Brown is a partner with Stoel Rives. Mr. Brown graduated from University of the Pacific, McGeorge School of Law in 1995 with great distinction and Order of the Coif and

has practiced since 1995. He has practiced law for over 20 years, including the representation of clients in complex commercial, construction, and real estate litigation. Mr. Brown has been named in the Best Lawyers in America for fourteen straight years, since 2006, and was named by *Best Lawyers* as "Lawyer of the Year" in Land Use and Zoning litigation in 2014. Mr. Brown's rate of \$538-595 is within the range of market rates charged for attorneys in the Sacramento area with similar skill and experience.

- 15. Christopher Pooser is a partner with Stoel Rives and is also the office managing partner for Stoel Rives' Boise office. Mr. Pooser is an appellate attorney representing clients before federal and state appellate courts, including the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals and Idaho Supreme Court. Mr. Pooser graduated from Tulane University Law School and was admitted to practice in Idaho in 1996. Mr. Pooser's rate of \$544-570 is the range of market rates charged for attorneys in the Boise area with similar skill and experience.
- 16. Whitney Brown is an associate with Stoel Rives. Ms. Brown graduated from University of California, Los Angeles School of Law and was admitted to practice in California in 2018. Ms. Brown has experience in complex litigation matters in both state and federal courts. Ms. Brown also has rich experience in appellate law garnered through four clerkships on federal and state courts of appeals. Ms. Brown served as a law clerk to Associate Justice Sonia Sotomayor of the U.S. Supreme Court. Prior to clerking for Justice Sotomayor, Whitney served as a law clerk to the Honorable Guido Calabresi of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, the Honorable Goodwin H. Liu of the Supreme Court of California, and the Honorable Morgan Christen of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. Ms. Brown's rate of \$355-375 is within the range of market rates charged for attorneys in the Sacramento area with similar skill and experience.
- 17. Lauren Neuhaus is an associate attorney at Stoel Rives. Ms. Neuhaus graduated from the University of California, Davis School of Law with the highest distinction and was admitted to practice in California in 2019. Ms. Neuhaus has experience in permitting, compliance, and enforcement matters arising under state and federal environmental laws. Ms. Neuhaus' rate of \$323-355 per hour is within the range of market rates charged for attorneys in the Sacramento area with similar skill and experience.

18. Wade Foster is an associate with Stoel Rives. Mr. Foster graduated from the University of Virginia School of Law and is admitted to practice in Idaho, Utah and Washington. Mr. Foster's practice focuses on mining, state water rights, and compliance counseling for clients subject to federal and state environmental laws. Mr. Foster previously served as a clerk to the Honorable B. Lynn Winmill of the U.S. District Court for the District of Idaho. Mr. Foster's rate of \$441 is within the range of market rates charged for attorneys in the Sacramento area with similar skill and experience.

- 19. Janelle Krattiger previously worked as an associate attorney with Stoel Rives. Ms. Krattiger's practice primarily focused on water rights and natural resources, often advising clients on matters regarding regulatory compliance, including state and federal Clean Water Acts, state and federal Endangered Species Acts (CESA and ESA), California Environmental Quality Act and National Environmental Policy Act, and Sustainable Groundwater Management Act. She represents clients before various local, state, and federal agencies, including counties, California Department of Fish and Wildlife, State Water Resources Control Board, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, and Bureau of Land Management. Ms. Krattiger's rate of \$370 is within the range of market rates charged for attorneys in the Sacramento area with similar skill and experience.
- 20. Max Fujii previously worked as an associate attorney with Stoel Rives. Mr. Fujii graduated from University of California, Davis School of Law and admitted to practice in California 2021. Mr. Fujii's rate of \$337 is within the range of market rates charged for attorneys in the Sacramento area with similar skill and experience.
- 21. Ha Nguyen is a certified paralegal at Stoel Rives. Ms. Nguyen has extensive experience providing litigation support, and provided various documents and support tasks with respect to this proceeding. Ms. Nguyen graduated from University of California, Davis in 2002. Ms. Nguyen's rate of \$218-295 per hour is within the range of market rates charged for paralegals in the Sacramento area with similar skill and experience.
- 22. Ontario's counsels' hourly rates of \$323-595 per hour are reasonable considering the Ontario's counsels' skill and experience and market rates charged in the Sacramento area. Ontario's counsels' actual rates are also well within the range of market rates charged by private

attorneys of similar skill, reputation, and experience for comparably complex proceedings. Ontario's paralegal rate of \$218-295 is also reasonable considering the market rates charged in Sacramento County. The knowledge and experience that Stoel Rives possesses in representing clients in a variety of water rights and litigation matters has allowed the firm to handle this matter efficiently and cost-effectively.

- 23. Stoel Rives incurred 538.8 hours, for a total of \$218,247.98, related to the challenge of the approval of the FY 2021/2022 Assessment Package. The challenge involved the filing an ex parte application and subsequent comprehensive combined 45-page reply brief in support of the motion challenging the Watermaster's approval of the Assessment Package, all within six weeks of being retained as counsel for Ontario. This time also included preparation for and attending the hearing on the challenge.
- 24. Stoel Rives incurred 253.2 hours, for a total of \$105,953.64, related to the challenge of the approval of the FY 2022/2023 Assessment Package. The challenge involved the filing of the motion and reply brief and attending the hearing on the challenge.
- 25. Stoel Rives incurred 769.5 hours, for a total of \$319,729.45, related to the appeals of the two orders denying the challenges to the approvals of the FY 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 Assessment Packages. The appeals included substantial briefing, a motion to consolidate, and oral argument. The record on appeal consisted of a combined 19 volumes of the parties' appendix, totaling 6,461 pages.
- 26. Stoel Rives has additionally incurred 60.4 hours, for a total of \$27,339.80, in drafting this motion for attorney's fees and costs.
- 27. I anticipate an additional 15 hours to complete work on the instant motion, including preparation of the reply brief and arguing the motion at the hearing. I anticipate that Mr. Foster will expend an additional 8 hours, Ha Nguyen an additional 3 hours, and an additional 4 hours of my time will be necessary to complete the work on this motion.
- 28. The total amount of Stoel Rives attorney fees requested, through the date of the hearing and including the work required to bring this matter to completion, is \$677,623.87.
